Course Descriptions

Asbestos Safety for Water Operators: A half-day course that looks at the importance of the safe handling of asbestos cement pipe in the distribution system. Also presented are proper disposal, equipment, history and health issues.

Basic to Advanced Math for Water Operators: A half-day course that will begin with a basic math review and move into formulas commonly used in the industry with an emphasis on preparing attendees to successfully take certification exams.

Injector Pumps: Good, Bad & the Ugly: A five-hour course that looks at the application and use relative to various types of treatments for both water and wastewater operators. Maintenance and troubleshooting will be presented.

Managing and Owning a Public Water System: A one-day course that will look at regulations, liability and rate setting for a public water system with an emphasis on running a business.

Oregon Administrative Rules Review: A half-day course that will present the current OAR, how they affect the day to day operations of a public water system and how they apply to certification exams.

Water Distribution Exam Review: This two-day course provides an exam review to prepare attendees to take water distribution certification exams.

Water Treatment Operator Exam Review: This two-day course provides an exam review to prepare attendees to take water treatment or basic treatment operator certification exams.

What Your Chlorine Residual is Telling You: This half-day course will assist operators in understanding the benefits and importance of chlorine as a disinfectant and why it is important to maintain a residual.
