### COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

**Water Distribution Exam Review** - 2 days - Prepares students for all levels of water distribution certification exams. **Oregon Administrative Rules Review** - ½ day - An in-depth look at the current drinking water-related OAR as it applies to certification exams as well as day to day operations.

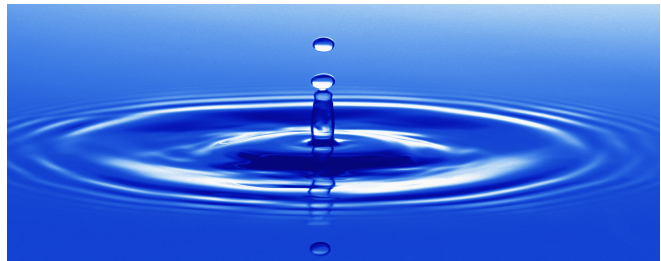
